## Criteria for payer coverage:

- 1. Patients who are current or past <u>cigarette</u> smokers ages 55–77 (age 80 for some non-Medicare payers)
  - Smoked at least an average of one pack a day for 30 years or more (or equivalent pack years). Please ensure this is documented in patient's social history-critical for coverage & reimbursement
  - Past smokers meet the above pack year history but have quit within the past <u>15</u> years.
  - Asymptomatic (no new symptoms i.e. worsening SOB, hemoptysis)
- 2. Smart set for Documentation for LDCT Lung Cancer Screening is now available in the rooming or assessment tab of the patient visit-click on smartset tab-in search type AHC CT Lung Screening-and the below will pop up. The appropriate areas will auto default and then populate your note. The primary diagnosis code will also be default checked but an additional diagnosis code needs to be selected.



- 3. For baseline & annual LDCT (lung RADS category 1 or 2) **order CT Chest Lung Cancer Screening** which is IMG 1242
- 4. For short term follow-up LDCT (lung RADS category 3 or 4) **order CT Chest Lung Cancer Screening Short Term Follow-up** which is IMG 6794
